Established by CODE – a Canadian charitable organization that supports literacy and learning - in collaboration with the Literary Prizes Foundation, the Burt Award for First Nations, Métis and Inuit Literature is given annually to English-language literary works for Young Adults by First Nations, Métis or Inuit authors.

A First Prize of \$12,000, a Second Prize of \$8,000 and a Third Prize of \$5,000 will be awarded to the authors and translators (if applicable) of the winning titles. Publishers of winning titles will be awarded a guaranteed purchase of a minimum of **2,500 copies**, which will be delivered to First Nations, Métis and Inuit youth across Canada.
