The Saskatchewan Indian Cultural Centre (SICC) is issuing a Call for Applications to the Birds of Prey Program. This program provides access to Birds of Prey feathers and other body parts from Eagles, Hawks and other raptors by Saskatchewan First Nations individuals, First Nations and First Nations institutions for use in ceremonial traditions and sacred practices. Saskatchewan First Nations individuals wishing to request Birds of Prey feathers and other body parts must complete "Part A" of the attached SICC Birds of Prey Application Form. And for those Saskatchewan First Nations' Institutions wishing to request Birds of Prey feathers for ceremonial purposes, they will require the completion of "Part B" of the same application form indicated above. SICC Birds of Prey Program - Key Dates

The Birds of Prey Program Call for Proposals will be done mid-January, 2015. All applications will be faxed to band offices and First Nations institutions. Please ensure that your applications are in to the SICC prior to the deadline.

The deadline for applications to the 2015 Birds of Prey Program is Thursday, April 30, 2015 at 4:00 pm CST. The Saskatchewan Indian Cultural Centre will not accept applications after this date.

A review of the applications will be done the first week of May, 2015. The SICC Elders Council will review all applications and make their recommendations for approval.

Successful applicants for the Birds of Prey Program will be notified immediately after the SICC Elders Council meets. Additionally, the SICC will notify all applicants, in writing, the results of the decisions of the SICC Elders Council.

The 2015 Birds of Prey Program Feather Issuance ceremony will occur the week of May 18-22, 2015. Successful applicants are obligated to obtain their feathers and other items in PERSON and are responsible for their travel costs for the Feather Issuance Ceremony. An offering of tobacco and cloth are considered appropriate protocols.
